Dear Parents and Guardians,



PLRS BADMINTON WRAP UP 2023



Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) - Trades

If you are ready to learn and practice your future trade while you are in high school, the Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) is an ideal program.

Register as a RAP apprentice and get a head-start on your career. Your employer will give you an inside look at your chosen trade to help you decide if that trade is right for you.

Work in the trade of your choice:

- part-time during the whole school year,
- for a semester,
- on weekends and holidays, or
- during the summer.

As you work, you will earn:

- wages,
- · high school credit, and
- on-the-job apprenticeship hours for a head -start toward journeyperson certification after high school.

When you complete high school:

- Your RAP apprenticeship ends,
- You are automatically registered as a regular apprentice, and
- the on-the-job hours you earned while in RAP are applied to your apprenticeship program.

My Pass


myPass is an Alberta Education self-service website for students to:

- Order high school transcripts in English and French
- √ View diploma exam marks
- Register to write or rewrite diploma exams with online payment
- √ View and print Detailed Academic Reports (DAR)
- View progress towards a credential (diploma or certificate)
- Order additional copies of an awarded credential in English or French
- Receive notifications for important messages

Sign Up for SafeArrival



To sign up for SafeArrival:

- Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at go.schoolmessenger.ca). The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account (you will need to verify via your email).
- 2. Use the SafeArrival website, **go.schoolmessenger.ca**. The first time you use the website, select **Sign Up** to create your account (you will need to verify via your email).

NOTE: your email address MUST match what is in PowerSchool.

Reporting an Absence



With **SafeArrival**, you are asked to report your child's absence in advance using any of these 3 convenient methods:

- 1. Using your mobile device, log into the **SchoolMessenger app.** Then select **Attendance** then **Report an Absence**.
- Use the SafeArrival website, log into your account at go.schoolmessenger.ca. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- 3. Call the toll-free number **1-833-525-9071** to report an absence using the automated phone system.
